



## China's bauxite import volume from Malaysia down by 23.5% MOM in May

BEIJING (Asian Metal) 26 Jun 15 - According to China Customs, China imported around 1.58 million tonnes of bauxite from Malaysia in May, down by around 23.5% MOM. China imported around 6.13 million tonnes of bauxite from Malaysia from January to May in total, accounting for 33% of Chinese total bauxite imports.

In May, Chinese total bauxite imports volume touched around 3.83 million tonnes, down by 18.8% MOM. In the first five months of 2015, the total volume reached around 18.56 million tonnes, up by 12.15% YOY.

The bauxite import volume retreat in May was mainly attributed to the decline from Malaysia. Many illegal mining companies halted production in Malaysia because of the strict land transportation inspection, which led to bauxite supply decrease. The volume from Malaysia may continue to keep at around 1.5 million tonnes in June.

The import volume from Australia maintained stable at around 1.6 million tonnes in May. Besides, China imported some bauxite from the Dominican Republic, Ghana and Fiji. We can see details by the following table:
